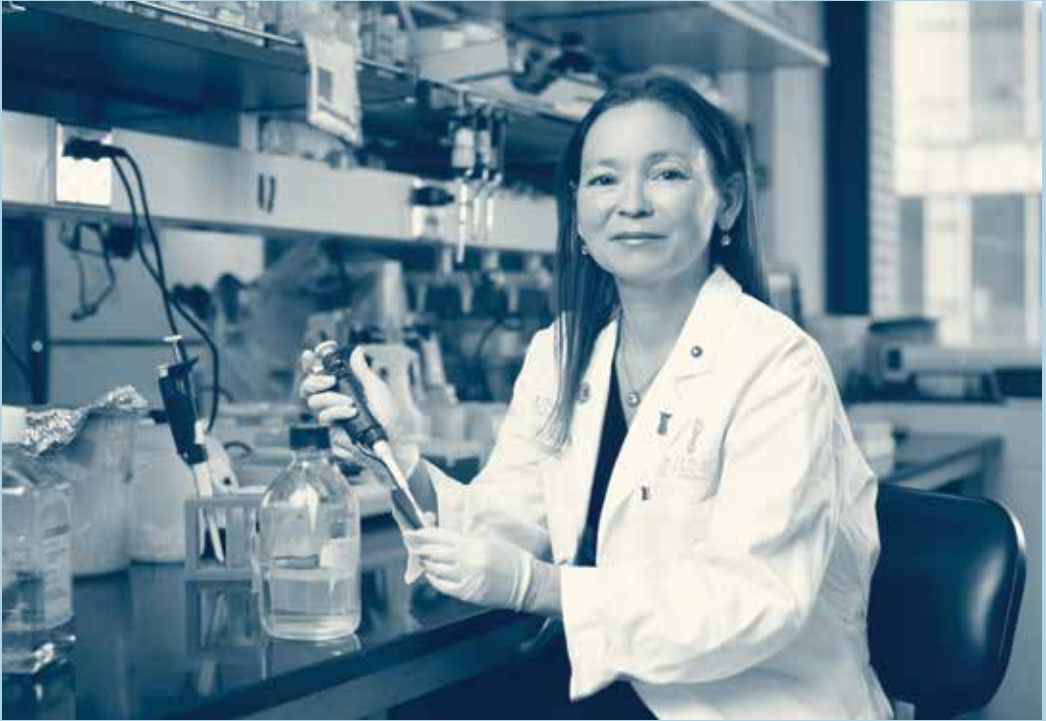

WHY DOES THE V FOUNDATION FUND COLORECTAL CANCER RESEARCH?

Colorectal cancer is now the leading cause of cancer death for men and second for women under the age of 50. In 2024, an estimated 152,720 colorectal cancer cases will be diagnosed.

The good news is colorectal cancer mortality rates have dropped by 56% from 1970 to 2021. Early detection through screening, and improvements in treatment – tied to the impact of cancer research – are contributors to mortality rates dropping.



The V Foundation has received 12 consecutive 4-star ratings from Charity Navigator, a leading charity evaluator, placing it among the top 2% of all charities evaluated.



The V Foundation is also a GuideStar Platinum-rated charity.

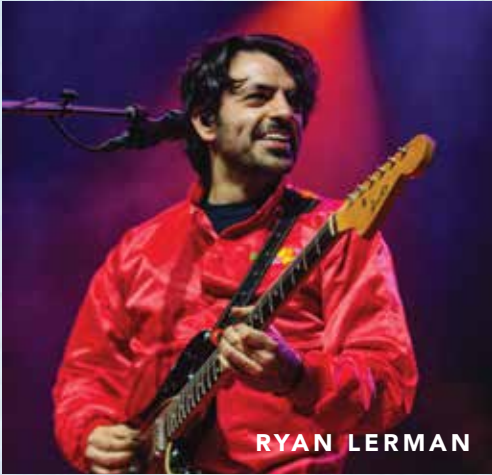

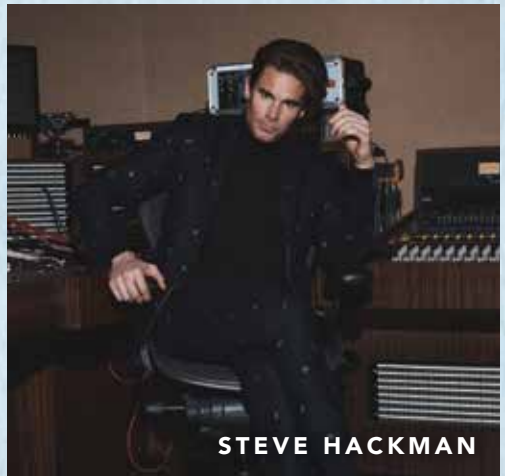

Founder & CEO, Eleven Eleven Winery

Ellie Anest grew up in Nebraska on a working farm. Her father owned and operated a farming operation which included cattle, sugar beets, soybeans, and corn. Her mother was self-taught, and creative in the areas of cooking, gardening, and decor. Her parents' ability to nurture seeds into valuable crops inspired her to cultivate ideas and bring them to life. At age 20, Ellie moved to San Diego where she attended San Diego State University and earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology and Accounting. While there, she became involved in philanthropy through the local Greek community, and soon met Carol Vassiliadis. Over time, they cultivated a deep friendship that ultimately led to their partnership and the creation of Eleven Eleven Winery.

Before founding Eleven Eleven, Ellie built a broad resume working with Fortune 500 companies and also owned and operated her own business, Anest Financial Solutions. Through the course of her career, Ellie's entrepreneurial spirit has prevailed. Her years of business experience, combined with strong values of quality and customer service, laid the foundation for the partnership venture of Eleven Eleven Winery.

Gala Executive Chef

Dustin Valette

Chef and Owner of The Matheson, Valette Restaurant, and Valette Wines

Chef Dustin Valette's culinary passion is sourced from his great-grandfather Honoré Valette's cellar, fragrant with hanging salumi or picked grapes from his uncle's vineyard. The traditions and skill he witnessed there has brought him far from that basement, and then right back to it. Now 40, he lives with his wife and their two children, in the Victorian farmhouse where Honoré lived in the 1930's.

After graduating from the Culinary Institute of America at Hyde Park in 2000, Chef Valette worked at San Francisco's most exciting restaurants, Charles Nob Hill, Fifth Floor, La Folie, Fleur De Lis, Gary Danko, and Aqua. He also spent time at Thomas Keller's one-Michelin-star Bouchon in the Napa Valley and Hokusai at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel Honolulu. He later took a cook's tour of Europe and saw how sustainability and tradition run deeper than mere sourcing.

Chef Valette and his brother Aaron made a pact to open their own restaurant someday and in 2015, that fraternal commitment became a reality when Valette opened in downtown Healdsburg. The menu at Valette is noted for its inventive and flavorful California cuisine, highlighting Chef Valette's French technique and proudly featuring ingredients sourced from Sonoma County.

Valette's curiosity about winemaking developed when tasting wines, building wine programs, and creating wine and food pairing menus over the years. He decided to start a small production wine brand, Valette Wine, made in collaboration with three notable winemakers, Bob Cabral (Pinot Noir and Rosé of Pinot Noir), Jesse Katz (Cabernet Sauvignon), and Tom Rochioli (Chardonnay), each masterful stewards of their favored varietal.

Chef Valette's latest venture, The Matheson, has grown from a glass of wine with his now business partner, Craig Ramsey, to a restaurant, a sushi kitchen with chef Ken Tominaga, and rooftop lounge on the Plaza. The building was the original location of Honoré's Snowflake Bakery, which is integral to the project. Chef Valette's menu is a modern ode to micro-seasonal ingredients. For Chef Valette, finding the limitlessness in the specific offerings of the moment is a play of craft and passion.

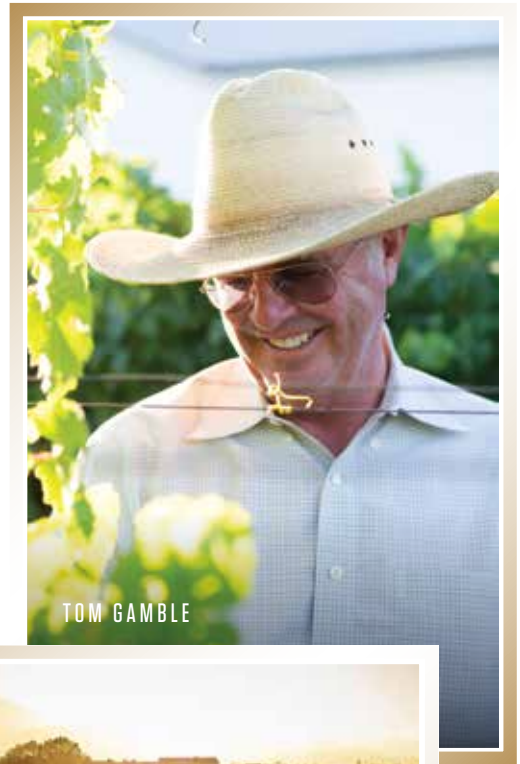
Gamble Family Vineyards

This masterpiece of Pinot Noir was hand harvested in September of 2022 and intentionally crafted in the cellar by noted winemaker Matt Taylor to intensify the fruit flavors and structure that were already present from the grapes of this amazing vineyard owned and farmed by Lee Martinelli. Matt worked with Lee to interplant vines within certain blocks of the vineyard, specifically for this wine. The grapes were whole cluster pressed, a technique favored by Matt, to balance the acidity and fruit with structural integrity. The resultant wine is loaded with structural complexity, along with floral, savory and spice aromatics that combine the red, and more importantly the blue fruit components that are characteristic of high density farming. This wine is a testament to Matt's viticulture and winemaking mastery.

Quite accessible for such a young wine yet shows incredible promise as a special bottle to age for 10+ years.
